A Collective of Visionaries



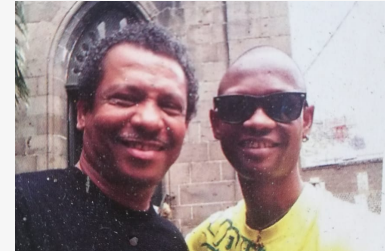
Mission

Programs aimed at using art therapy to support mental health in marginalized communities.

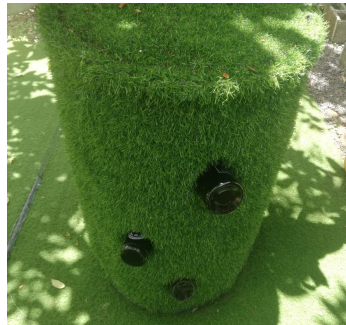
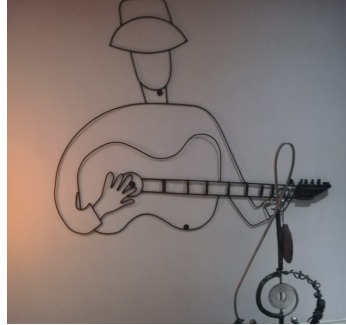
Cultural Preservation:

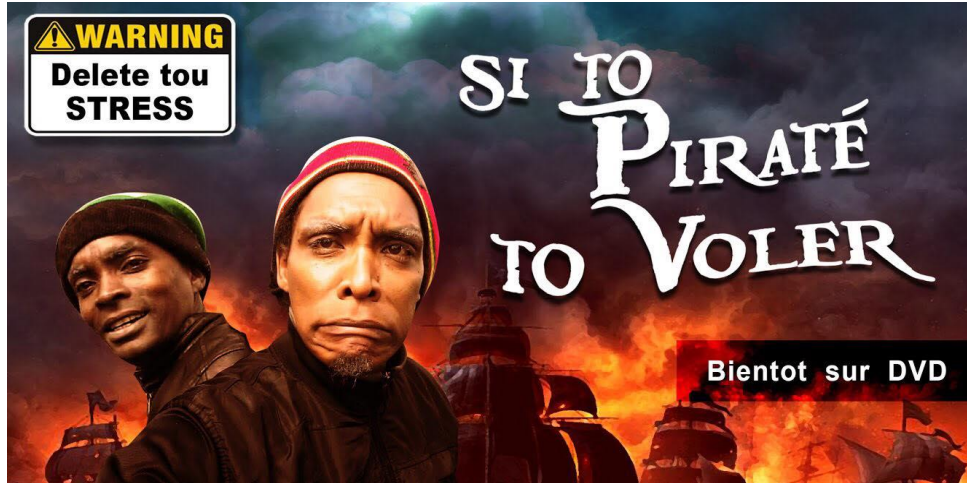

Hosting a collaborative art festival with Ascencia, featuring over 100 artists.

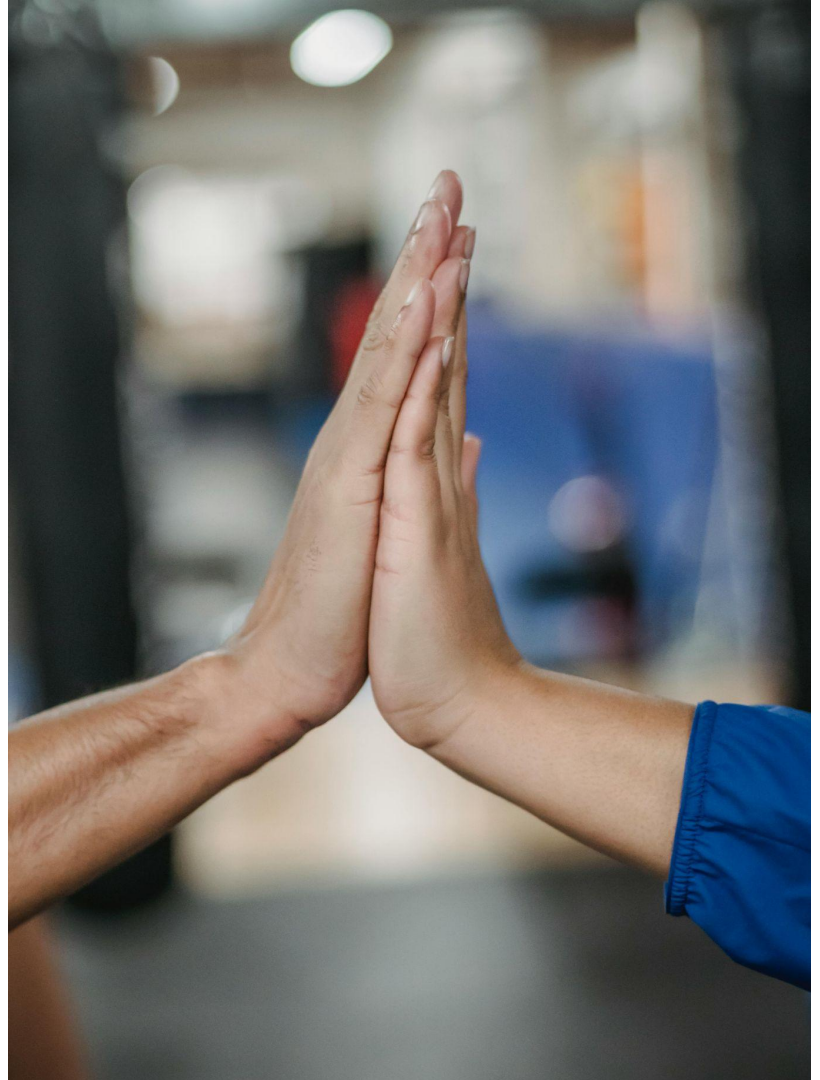
